OFFERING SUBJECTS AT MORE DEMANDING LEVELS

For English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and/or Science, students can offer them at the start of Secondary 1 at a more demanding level if they meet the eligibility criteria based on PSLE results:

Beyond the start of Sec 1, students may offer subjects at a more demanding level if found suitable to do so. The eligibility criteria are:

Students who offered English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics, Science, and/or Humanities subjects at a more demanding level (including HMTL) in lower secondary will be offered the option to continue offering the subjects at the same subject level in upper secondary if they are able to cope with the demands of the subjects at that subject level (i.e. obtained at least an overall pass in the respective subjects in Sec 2). This will provide students the opportunity to further deepen their mastery of content and skills in the subject area of strength.
